

Quick Reference Card Update

Additional speech recognition commands

With speech recognition, you can listen to voice, fax, or e-mail messages and respond to system prompts by saying a few words. To use voice commands, just start speaking. Or, you can respond by pressing touchtone keys at any time. During voice or e-mail message playback, you can say the commands listed in the following tables. The words in **bold** are required.

NOTES: When the system is reading who received an e-mail message or its subject, you can say "Yes" to skip ahead to the body of the message or you can say "No" to save the message as new then go to the next message.

To cancel out of composing or redirecting a message, say *End*.

During voice message playback	
Say the following commands.

Slow down playback	[4]
Adjust volume	[5]
Speed up playback	[6]
Rewind ¹	[7]
Pause	[8]
Fast forward	[9]
Repeat message	[#]
Save as new	[*]
Reply	[3] [4]
Skip ²	[3] [5]
Delete message	[3] [6]
Archive	[3] [7]
Redirect	[3] [9]

During e-mail message playback	
Say the following commands.	
Words in bold are required.	or Press
Menu options	[3]
Rewind ¹	[7]
Pause	[8]
Fast forward	[9]
Repeat message	[#]
Save as new	[*]
Reply	[3] [4]
Skip ²	[3] [5]
Delete message	[3] [6]
Redirect	[3] [9]

1.If the message does not rewind completely, say **Repeat** to repeat the entire message.

2.The system marks skipped messages as *read* then moves on to the next message.
